<sup>1</sup> **The standard rate** includes Doubles, Triples and Quads in Blackstone, Gregory, Harlan, Lois, McClure, Nollen and Roberts, and Stairwell Singles in Gregory, McClure and Roberts. **The rate is \$7100** for a "regular Single" in the above residence halls as well as Cleveland-Young and Deerpath, and also Doubles and Triples in both Cleveland Young and Deerpath. **The rate is \$8200** for Suites in Cleveland-Young and Deerpath, and all rooms in Moore.

<sup>2</sup> **Choose from three plans**, each with the same cost. Plans are based on the number of "all you can eat meals" in the cafeteria and "flex dollars" to use around campus. **Options include** 10-meals/week + \$980 flex dollars per semester, 15-meals/week + \$530 flex dollars, 21-meals/week + \$215 flex dollars.

<sup>3</sup> Examples include laundry, toiletries, entertainment, etc.

<sup>4</sup> **All students** must be covered by a U.S. health insurance plan. Students without insurance are billed for the College's plan. Full-year coverage runs from August to August. Single-semester coverage (January to August) of \$1200 is available for those transferring to the College mid-year. This charge will appear on the initial bill, until and unless proof of acceptable U.S. insurance is provided via the online insurance waiver, available in the summer.

<sup>5</sup> Charged to all new students, in their first semester of enrollment. It is not applied toward tuition.
