

Costs for the 2025 – 2026 Academic Year

Direct Costs will appear on your billing statement while **Indirect Costs** will not. Your *direct costs* may vary, based on your housing assignment and use of the College's health insurance plan. Your actual *indirect costs* may vary, given individual spending habits; the amounts shown are suggested starting points.

Official charges are billed by our Student Accounts team (Business Office) and may differ from those shown.

¹ The standard rate includes Doubles, Triples and Ouads in Blackstone, Gregory, Harlan, Lois, McClure, Nollen and Roberts, and Stairwell Singles in Gregory, McClure and Roberts. The rate is \$7488 for a "regular Single" in the above residence halls, for Singles, Doubles and Triples in both Cleveland Young and Deerpath, and for all Campus Apartments. The rate* is \$8640 for Suites in Deerpath, and all rooms in Moore and Arrive.

² Choose from three plans, each with the same cost. Plans are based on the number of "all you can eat meals" in the cafeteria and "flex dollars" to use around campus. Options include* 10-meals/wk + \$980 Boomer Bucks per semester, 15-meals/wk + \$530 Boomer Bucks, 21-meals/wk + \$215 Boomer Bucks. (Boomer Bucks or "flex dollars" can be used in any dining facility on campus operated by Parkhurst Dining.

³ Examples include laundry, toiletries, entertainment, etc.

⁴ All students must be covered by a U.S. health insurance plan. Students without insurance are billed for the College's plan. Full-year coverage runs from August to August. Single-semester coverage (January to August) is available for those transferring to the College mid-year. This charge will appear on the initial bill, until and unless proof of acceptable U.S. insurance is provided via the online insurance waiver, available in the summer.
