Paper prompt (with key words italicized): "What was a turning point in 19-century *beliefs* regarding the connection between a *clean water supply and public health* in Chicago?"

Source #1: Ordinance to prevent filth from entering the water supply; Title: "An Ordinance, to prevent filth from entering into the Works of the Chicago Hydraulic Company from Lake Michigan" (1848), James H. Woodworth, Mayor of Chicago
